The God given journey comes with burning desires to see ministry in a globally connected world and lives impacted by God's Word live in Africa, Asia, Europe, and North, Central and South America.

Ministries include cross-generational Bible based discipleship, church planting in Germany, Portugal, U.S. and very rural villages of Western Nepal. Nursing home ministry, surfers finding Christ, post abortion Bible study, orphans cared for, refugee ministry, and online ministries which include Brazilian Chinese taught by a missionary in Texas.

We continue to serve as the Ministry Leader and Administrator of Be One Together. We added 2 leadership couples serving as Ministry Center Liaison's: David and Shari Oberg (Washington) help with the Western US and Moises and Luzimar Moura (Texas) help with international ministries and Texas. Backroom needs of the mission (receipting money, financial books, and more) are provided by 2 part-time stay at home moms.

In the past 7.5 years we have served with 89 missionaries in 20 US states, 13 countries with over 100 languages spoken in short and long term ministries. It may surprise you to know Portuguese is the 2nd most spoken language among our missionaries! Missionaries from Brazil serve in Portugal and the U.S. and missionaries from Africa and Mexico minister in the U.S as well. We are witnessing a globally connected ministry which God has called us to. Locally we have been involved in mentoring/discipling men and women as well as others by virtual means. Mary recently finished teaching her 2nd virtual women's Bible Study.

Personal news: Our health continues to be good. Mary's cancer has not returned and she had a knee replaced in early February. Mike's parents continue to live with his brother Ed in Corvallis.

Last fiscal year 93.5% of all monies received by the mission were directly used in frontline ministry. This excites us. We continue to raise our support believing monies supplied for Be One Together missionaries and their ministries is to be used in ministry and therefore, Be One Together does not pay us a salary. During the first 6 months of this year we averaged about \$1-2,000 a month below our needed support level and saw God supply in many other ways to meet our needs. (Last week we were gifted 7# of ground beef.)

We covet your prayers as we continue in ministry trusting God to meet our needs and to expand His kingdom.
