In the highest mountains of the desolate Himalayas, House Churches is only the option in the absence of Church buildings and presence of local persecutions. The house fellowship groups are usually the first unit of care which offer love, care and sharing and foster communal living just like a family. The house fellowship encourages each other in the Lord and fosters the personal Christian growth and walk with God and it is an outlet to serve God and one another. There we can pray together, read the scriptures together, eat together and share our resources. It is a place to practice generosity and hospitality. Praise and Glory to our Lord!



Thank you all for your support and prayers to the mission field. Our Pastors succeeded in establishing 3 new house churches in the remotest villages. The fellowships are strong in these villages. More people are being added every week and the fire of the Holy Spirit is spreading all over the villages like wildfire. Despite working in the fields harvesting all day, believers get excited to hear God's Word and have praise and worship in the evening.

Celebrating Abundant Life in Christ

Baptism is an outward testimony of an inward transformation. It's the first step of obedience for a disciple of Christ. Our God is working and we are spreading the Gospel in the Himalayas. 7 people of Servant Heart Church of Western Nepal were baptized in the name of our triune God this month.



The Message of Hope Gets Stronger and Stronger

Our native pastors and missionaries realize that planting a seed that is the Word of God in the heart of a lost person can make all the difference in the world to them. It can change people's lives forever. That is why they are willing to endure the hardships of reaching these remote villages. That is why they are willing to walk up and down steep mountains on treacherous paths, many times in the cold and snow or the rain and mud. They know that that one opportunity that they have to plant that seed can lead to a great increase. Things are terrible but God is at work and He is using

us to share the message of salvation to the people living around us. Praise God that we were able share gospel to as many as people living in and around Western Nepal. 23 people from strong Hindu and





Buddhist backgrounds put their trust in Lord Jesus Christ. God is working even if we cannot see it. We are getting more inspired and motivated. Jesus said, "I will build my church, and the gates of hell will not prevail against it". With the Lord's help and your prayer partnership with this ministry, our pastors and people continue to reach out to the lost. We're growing and God is using our brothers and sisters who have no Bible training to win souls and plant new churches in the uttermost parts of the unreached areas

of our region. Everywhere we go we preach a simple message of God's love and His Grace, yet, people are turning to the Lord. This is the power of your prayers.

They are willing to endure persecutions, beatings, threatening, torture, and rejection to share the Gospel. They have seen people who once beat them and threatened them now serving in the church or leading a house church meeting. The Gospel has the power to change a person completely!
