At the end of January the youth staff went to Chattanooga for Conclave, a youth ministers conference. We do this every year




because of the wealth of knowledge we get about youth as well as the spiritual uplift it gives us to start the new year. Inside I will tell you more about Conclave.

Revival!!

Many of you may have heard of the revival at Asbury University in Wilmore, Kentucky. It started February 8, at a college worship time when one of the students came forward and started confessing his sins. Other people came forward and the Holy Spirit really moved. There was prayer, singing, confessing, and this continued seven days a week, 24 hours a day, until the 24th when the school shut it down because they didn't have the facilities to accommodate such large crowds. It spread to over 12 schools.

Revival is not unusual in the United States. In the 1730s there was a revival in new England which was known as the Great Awakening. It continued in the 1760s. There was a revival in the Methodist church in 1776. They only had 20 churches but it ended up growing into 19,000 by the Civil War. On April 9, 1906 a revival begin in California on Azusa Street and lasted till 1915 which started the Assemblies of God. In 1970 a revival started at Asbury University which started the Jesus movement.

Some things are pretty consistent about revivals. They usually start after a season of spiritual decline. It usually starts with young people when they begin to pray. The Holy Spirit first touches the hearts of individuals then He begins to move in the congregation. It seems like revival happens for two main reasons: To spiritually reinforce the church and to introduce others to a personal relationship with Christ. So, what is God preparing us for. Whatever it is, we have Jesus.
