

This fits the picture that we were given down there of families and whole (indigenous) villages coming out to work in the camps

harvesting for 9-10 months out of the year. Her childhood was spent in Culiacan. When asked if anyone came to her camp sharing about Jesus when she was there she sadly said no.

We are excited to be going again this year to this same Project. We will be going in January.
