Simple Budget Breakdown

1. Church Planting (5 churches)
 - Estimated cost: \$50,000
 - (\$10,000 per church)

2. Support for 100 Widows

- Estimated cost: \$30,000
- (\$300 per widow over the 5 years)

3. Support for 50 Orphans

- Estimated cost: \$15,000
- (\$300 per orphan over the 5 years)

4. Support for 100 Farmers (Sustainable Agriculture)

- Estimated cost: \$25,000
- (\$250 per farmer for training and resources)

5. Water Wells for 10 Villages

- Estimated cost: \$40,000
- (\$4,000 per well)

6. Motorcycles and Vehicle for Evangelism to unreached villages

- Estimated cost: \$25,000
- (10 motorcycles at \$2,000 each, 1 vehicle at \$15,000)

7. Medical Assistance for the Poor

- Estimated cost: \$20,000
- (Annual medical outreach)

8. *Building 1 Primary School and 1 Vocational School*:

- Estimated cost: \$100,000
- (\$50,000 for each school)

Total Estimated Budget

- *Total*: \$315,000

The way school building maintenance.

1. Floating the floor

- Cost per bag: 210 Leone
- Number of bags needed: 50
- Total cost for floating the floor = $210 \text{ Leone} \times 50 \text{ bags} = 10,500 \text{ Leone}$

2. Doors

- Cost per door: 2000 Leone
- Number of doors: 4
- Total cost for doors = $2000 \text{ Leone} \times 4 \text{ doors} = 8,000 \text{ Leone}$

3. Windows

- Cost per window: 1000 Leone
- Number of windows: 4
- Total cost for windows = $1000 \text{ Leone} \times 4 \text{ windows} = 4,000 \text{ Leone}$

4. Paint

- Total cost for paint: 4000 Leone

Now, let's sum up all the costs to set the total budget:

- Total cost for floating the floor: 10,500 Leone
- Total cost for doors: 8,000 Leone
- Total cost for windows: 4,000 Leone
- Total cost for paint: 4,000 Leone

Total Budget Calculation:

{Total Budget} = 10,500 + 8,000 + 4,000 + 4,000 = 26,500 { Leone}

*Dear Mary

Greetings to you in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

I am writing with a heavy heart to inform you about one of our dear church members in Baiima, Sao Brima. You may recall that Sao was a Muslim who gave his life to Christ about three months ago, during our Jesus film outreach in Baiima. Since then, he has faithfully served as the caretaker of our new church plant there.

Sao's conversion was a great testimony — especially as his parents, though still Muslim, allowed him to join our fellowship. For the past two months, he has been cleaning the church every Sunday and serving with joy.

Unfortunately, just a few days ago, Sao began to experience severe pain in his lower back along with a fever. The pain worsened, and two days ago, he went to bed and suddenly became unable to move or speak. We rushed him to the hospital in Baiima, and he was later referred to Kenema. The doctors have diagnosed him with a stroke.

Right now, Sao is unable to move one of his hands and a foot. He is very emotional and often cries. This is a difficult time for him and for all of us who have seen the transformation in his life.
