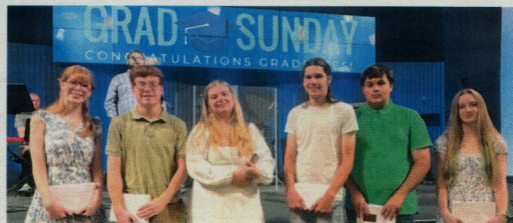


Ending School & Beginning Summer!!
